### We are all born free and equal

The Limestone District School Board is committed to creating an equitable, inclusive, and accessible school and work climate that upholds the **Ontario Human Rights Code**.



### Everyone is entitled to these rights

The Code recognizes that all people:

- Have human rights that cannot be infringed upon or dismissed.
- Have individual dignity and worth.
- Are entitled to equal rights and opportunities without discrimination.

### Respecting human rights is a collective responsibility

We all have a part to play in ensuring that everyone's human rights are respected.



### Everyone has the right to live in freedom and safety

The **Ontario Human Rights Code** prohibits discrimination on the following grounds:

- Age
- Ancestry, colour, race
- Citizenship
- Creed
- Disability | Perceived disability
- Discrimination because of association
- Ethnic origin
- Family status | Marital status (incl. single status)
- Gender identity and gender expression
- Place of origin
- Reprisal
- Sex
- Sexual orientation

### Your human rights are legally protected

The **Ontario Human Rights Code** is the human rights law in Ontario. You are legally protected from discrimination based on any of these grounds and have a right to an environment free from discrimination. ✨
